

# PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

South Holland District Council has made a Public Spaces Protection Order using the powers of Section 71 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014.

The Order has been introduced in order to improve the quality of life of those living, working and visiting the area.

The Public Spaces Protection Order applies to the area shown in the map overleaf.

**Under the terms of the Public Spaces Protection Order, the following activities are prohibited:**



**No drinking of alcohol in a public place**



**No urinating or defecating in the designated area**



**No depositing of litter**



**No spitting saliva or any other product of the mouth on the ground**



**Failure to comply with the order is an offence carrying a maximum fine of £1000 or a £100 Fixed Penalty Notice**
