





ECO Flex Guidance for Installers

Note - in this section:

- we/us/ Council = East Lindsey District Council/ Boston Borough Council / South Holland District Council
- you = approved ECO installer
- supplier = ECO obligated energy supplier
- householder = applicant
- Ofgem manages the ECO for the Department of Energy Security and Net Zero

1. Completing an application

You must submit applications using the Council's application form template which is available on our websites.

2. Submitting applications

You will submit applications to us on behalf of the householder. Installers must make sure the householder and property meet the eligibility criteria. Also, you must get any relevant evidence and submit it with the application. This includes the Improvement Option Evaluation with details of the pre-retrofit assessment, the EPC rating and the measures to be installed.

Email all applications and supporting documentation to greenhomesgrants@e-lindsey.gov.uk

Please make sure the householder does not submit the application themselves.

Declarations will not be issued unless all evidence if provided. Please refer to the Ofgem guidance for the most common sources of evidence that are required and the source Ofgem:ECO4 administration guidance

Please do not apply to us if the applicant receives means-tested benefits as ECO will apply. For further information visit Ofgem: Energy Company Obligation (ECO)

3. What you need to explain to the householder

You must explain to the householder that:

- ECO Flex is a private sector-led scheme
- energy companies award funding for improvements the Council has limited involvement. We are not responsible for:
 - o issuing the funding
 - appointing contractors
 - installing the works
 - o checking the quality of completed work

4. Branding

You must not use any Council branding or suggest you are working on our behalf.

5. Contact details

You must leave contact details with the householder. This includes named contact, telephone number and e-mail address.

Please tell the householder to contact you:

- for any enquiries
- to check on progress
- raise any concerns

They should not contact East Lindsey District Council, Boston Borough Council or South Holland District Council.

6. Extra Costs

You must tell householders of any works and extra costs which the ECO Flex scheme cannot fund. You should also explain that they may have to cover these extra costs.

Explain that they don't have to proceed if they think the work isn't appropriate or affordable.

7. Accreditation

All installers must be <u>TrustMark</u> accredited.

8. GDPR

All installers must follow the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

You will need to

- undertake work in line with Ofgem requirements
- act in line with industry best practices for consumer care and quality standards

10. The Council limits its involvement to the declaration of eligibility

By participating in the ECO Flex scheme we seek to support those who are:

- experiencing fuel poverty
- vulnerable to living in a cold home

As such we recommend you offer householders measure that are:

- the most affordable
- the most energy-efficient

The Council discourages you from undertaking cold calling face-to-face contact. We insist that you contact householders via phone, email, letter or a leaflet drop.

We will investigate any complaints received from householders about cold calling. This could result in us not issuing declarations.

11. Council endorsements

We are currently working with Everwarm Ltd and YES Energy Solutions directly, as a route for delivering ECO Flex in East Lindsey, Boston Borough and South Holland. However, this does not preclude participation by other companies.

Other than Everwarm Ltd and YES Energy Solutions, we are not directly endorsing any other company connected to

- the application process
- installation of ECO Flex grants or products

This includes:

- energy companies
- ECO installers/contractors
- grant agents

12. On-boarding

The Council does not have an on-boarding process, installers must meet the requirements set out by Ofgem/BEIS and be TrustMark accredited.
