



## Notice of Conclusion

### Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

**Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 – Section 17**  
**Electoral Administration Act 2006 – Section 16**  
**Representation of the People Act 1983 – Sections 18A – 18E and Schedule 1**

South Holland District Council has concluded a compulsory review of Polling Districts and Polling Places as required by Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

At a meeting of the Full Council held on 24 January 2024, the Council resolved to approve the following changes to polling districts and polling places.

Ward	Changes to polling districts and polling places
CRD1 – Crowland East	Relocation of Polling Place to Snowden Pavilion, off Thorney Road, Crowland
CRD2 – Crowland West	Relocation of Polling Place to Crowland Community Hall, Broadway, Crowland.
CRD4 – Deeping St Nicholas	Relocation of Polling Place to Deeping St Nicholas Church
CRD5 – Tongue End	Relocation of Polling Place to Deeping St Nicholas Church
PS1 & 2 - Pinchbeck	To relocate the following streets from Polling District PS2 to PS1 – Rotten Row, Primrose Crescent, The Chase, Fennell Road, Wayet Road, Brayfields, and odd numbers of Rose Lane
PS2 – Pinchbeck	Relocation of Polling Place to Pinchbeck Church Hall, Rose Lane, Pinchbeck
SC1 & SC2 – Spalding Castle	Merge of Polling Districts into one.
SSJ3 & SSJ4 – Spalding St Johns	Merge of Polling Districts into one.
SMK4 – Spalding Monkshouse	Confirmation of permanent relocation of Polling Place to Monkshouse Scout Hut, Monkshouse Lane, Spalding
SMK5 – Spalding Monkshouse	Confirmation of permanent relocation of Polling Place to Bromley Memorial Hall, Bourne Road, Spalding

All other polling districts and polling places remain unchanged following the review. Full details of polling arrangements for South Holland District Council are available for inspection.

The revised polling district and polling places will take effect from 1 February 2024.

Polling districts and polling places are kept under regular review. The next compulsory full review of polling districts and polling places will take place between October 2028 and January 2030.

However, South Holland District Council, will keep polling districts and polling places under review and comments or suggestions can be made at any time to the address given below.
